Housing and support for people street sleeping during Covid 19

Together Home Overview

- Since March 2020 in response to Covid 19
 - More than 9,000 people accessed TA
 - 1,500 had been street sleeping
- NSW Government invested \$36.1 million
 - \$14 million for temporary accommodation
 - \$20 million for additional private rental subsidies



Together Home Approach

- Rapid rehousing response with Housing First principles
 - Based on STEP Program including STEP to Home

- Housing First principles include
 - An individuals right to housing
 - Flexible / long term support
 - Separation of housing and support provision
 - Client centred services



Bridge Housing package

- Funded \$4.5 million over 2 years for housing & support
 - 45 leasehold properties
 - 45 support packages
- Bridge Housing to contract support partners
 - Reviewed existing partnerships and selected high performers
 - Divided into packages of 3 to manage risk
 - Mission Australia
 - St Vinnies
 - Salvos
 - Contract based on previous C 100 support agreement



Project Delivery

- Existing and new staff to implement project
 - A new Housing Manager portfolio (P10)
 - Smaller property numbers to reflect intensity of support
 - Consolidate P70, Connect 100, Step to Home and new Together Home tenancies (approx. 130)
 - A new temporary leasehold assistant to assist Leasehold Coordinator in property selections
 - Tenant Support Coordinator manage program
- Training on Housing First for these roles



Next Steps

- Client referrals from DCJ underway
- Contracts with support partners issued
- Recruitment to new / backfill roles underway
- Promotion to agents / landlords for new properties issued
- Target to house the first client in Homelessness Persons Week from 3 August
