

Bridge Buddies

Code of Conduct

Scope

The Code of Conduct covers anyone who is participating in the Bridge Buddies program. Bridge Buddies are responsible for following the Code of Conduct whilst they participate in the program. They must also use the Code of Conduct to guide their behaviour and decision making while they are enrolled in the program.

It is nice to be nice!

All tenants participating in Bridge Buddies are expected to:

- Treat your buddy with respect regardless of their cultural identity, race, ability, gender, sexual orientation or age. Treat your buddy the way you would like to be treated.
- Share your experiences as a Bridge Housing tenant to help new Bridge Housing tenants settle in to their home and neighbourhood.
- Stick to the contact times you have both agreed to. Don't contact your buddy early in the morning or late at night (unless you arranged your phone calls that way).
- Let the Bridge Housing Community Team know immediately if you have any concerns about your Buddy's wellbeing or welfare.

There are some behaviours that will not be tolerated in Bridge Buddies program. These includes:

- Offensive language, including swearing and racial slurs
- Showing aggression through yelling or making emotional gestures
- Speaking with your friend while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Bridge Buddies has a zero tolerance to discrimination, bullying and harassment. If you are experiencing bullying, harassment or discrimination from your Buddy please call the Community Team on 8324 0800. You may be asked to leave the program if we believe you have been engaging in this type of behaviour.

Who to call.

All Bridge Housing tenants need to contact Bridge Housing if:

- You get into difficulty with rent or water payments
- Your property needs any repairs or maintenance.
- Your personal details or circumstances change.
- You need to report nuisance and annoyance issues.

Remember, talking to your buddy is not the same as talking to your Housing Manager at Bridge Housing.

No-fault departure

Bridge Buddies operates on no-fault departure. This means that the buddy connection can be ended at any time by request of either tenant. The request will be respected by both parties and no blame will be assigned or discussion entered in to about the ending of a buddy agreement.

Important things to remember.

- If your buddy has a question about Bridge Housing that you don't know the answer to, that's ok. You can tell your Buddy to call Bridge Housing or make a note of the question and talk to your Housing Manager or a member of the Community Team to find out the answer.
- Let your buddy know about Bridge events and initiatives you have been involved in and enjoyed.
- Share your experience as a Bridge Housing Tenant. This might include knowing how to pay rent, what to provide at Rent Review, and what happens at a property inspection, requesting a block meeting.
- If you have concerns about your Buddy's welfare, call your Housing Manager or the Community Team straight away.
- Being a buddy shouldn't be a chore, so tell us if it has become too time consuming, if your buddy is calling you at inappropriate times or is causing you difficulties.
- If a buddy makes another tenant feel uncomfortable, or acts inappropriately Bridge Housing will investigate and may ask them to leave the program.

If you are concerned about your Buddy, feel uncomfortable with anything shared by your Buddy or you need assistance with your Buddy, please let the Community Team know as soon as possible.

Important things to note.

To be eligible for Bridge Buddies program you must agree to and meet the following points:

- You must not be subject to any ongoing dispute with Bridge Housing, such as noise and nuisance, or Notice of Termination in order to apply
- You must be at least 18 years old.
- Bridge Housing or the tenant can end the agreement at any time
- Should an issue arise Bridge Housing will refer to the Complaints and Grievance Handling Procedure and other related policies outlined in the agreement
- All participants and Bridge Housing have a shared responsibility for making sure the program is safe for all. If tenants become aware of a Health or Safety risk they must make Bridge Housing aware of the issue.
