Have Your Say and Get Involved

There are many opportunities at Bridge Housing for you to have your say in how we deliver our services. By getting involved, you could make a real difference to people's lives and communities.



We are committed to including you in a way that suits you, so we work hard to make sure that there are many different ways to get involved. This includes ways you can get involved from the comfort of your own home through to attending meetings and workshops.

Here are the ways you can get involved:

Tenant Satisfaction Survey – Our tenant survey aims to get your feedback about your experience and wellbeing as a Bridge Housing tenant. This gives us a good snapshot of how we are going and areas we can improve on. Our next survey will go out at the start of 2019 and we encourage you to take some time to fill it out and send it back to us.

Time to Talk – these groups are an opportunity for different communities of tenants to gather together and meet with Bridge Housing staff, to speak in their own language or talk about issues of importance to them. For example, this might be Arabic speaking tenants, LGBTIQ tenants, or young tenants.

Your Views E-Panel – get involved without leaving your home! The Your Views E-Panel lets tenants provide input and comments on a range of Bridge Housing letters, forms and factsheets. This is all done via email and at a time that suits you.

Tenant Advisory Groups (TAG) – five tenant groups meet regularly. You can choose which meeting is best for you based on the type of group or location. **Redfern** - Central TAG, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Tenants, Vietnamese Tenants **Bondi Junction** - East TAG **Parramatta** - West TAG

Maintenance Management Committee -

this committee is an internal working group who oversee the delivery of our repairs and maintenance contract. The committee consists of Bridge staff, contractors and tenant representatives. The tenants on the committee are selected through an Expression of Interest process based on relevant experience.

Workshops and Focus Groups – Bridge Housing staff will often meet with tenants in workshops and focus groups to hear from you about specific topics and to get your feedback on new policies, procedures, documents and plans. We also hold Good Neighbours workshops throughout the year that focus on being a good neighbour and understanding our Good Neighbour Policy. You don't have to commit to ongoing meetings, you can come to any workshops that you are interested in. Invitations and information are sent by post and email and are posted on Facebook as the workshops are scheduled.

Block Meetings – Block Meetings give tenants the chance to discuss any concerns they have in their block, meet their neighbours, exchange information about local services and programs, and discuss positive ideas for change. Block Meetings are scheduled by a Housing Manager and are a great opportunity to meet Bridge staff and hear about what is happening.



Become a member and attend the AGM

- all Bridge Housing tenants are invited to become members of Bridge Housing for the duration of their tenancy with us. As a member, you are able to vote at the AGM each year. Projects with your neighbours – did you know that many Bridge tenants have beautiful community gardens that are looked after by tenants? Bridge can support you to build a garden at your block with a group of your neighbours through the Royal Botanic Gardens Community Greening program. Other tenants have applied for a Big Ideas Grant and used the funds to host block parties, art clubs and community events. If you have an idea for your block or community, then a Big Ideas Grant may help make that idea become a reality.

March Rent Review

The March Rent Review is underway and if you haven't already received your review notification letter or returned your rent review documents, please contact the rent review team as soon as possible. Without these important documents, we cannot calculate your rental subsidy and may have to charge you full market rent for your property. Some important dates to remember:

Centrelink changes pension and benefit payments from the **20 March 2018**

Your rent will change on **Monday 9** April 2018

We have streamlined the process for tenants who receive Centrelink payments only and have signed an Income Confirmation Authority (ICA) form. If you have signed the ICA form you will only need to provide income details when we conduct an audit or if there is a problem accessing information from Centrelink. If you haven't signed an ICA form and would like to take advantage of this new arrangement please contact Bridge Housing and we will send you a form.

If you and your household receive income from sources other than Centrelink, you will need to continue to submit the application for rental subsidy form and provide your household income details to Bridge Housing.

Northern Beaches Update

Bridge Housing has been busy preparing for the arrival of our new Social Housing Management Transfer tenants on the Northern Beaches in July 2019.

We are starting to:

- ► Meet with the other Northern District providers Link Housing and SGCH, and with local support agencies
- ► Talk to the Tenant Participation Resource Service.

In 2019, we will be holding tenant forums and block meetings to better understand tenants' transition needs.
